 - 2007




- \checkmark Handed back to the people by the 4th Monarch

 - Mumbai from NAM

 - HM realized that the existing development paradigm (GDP) did not consider the ultimate goal of every human being – HAPPINESS
- HM the Fourth King Jigme Singye Wangchuck
 - "Sem Gochoep Zoni"
 - Peace and harmony within oneself and promoting peace and harmony in others
 - Mindfulness Education

Educating for GNH at RUB



1. GNH/Value Education Course

- A foundation program for all students from July 2013
- RUB Colleges have UHV core groups

2. GNH Consistent Pedagogy

Launched in February 2012 to be continued into the next five to ten years

3. Mindfulness/Awareness Education

 Mindfulness Education Associations created - promote an informal but pervasive environment for mindfulness practice (teachings, talks and discussions, non credited programs, mindfulness practice sessions)





- Hon'ble VC of RUB attended 1st Int'l Conference on Human Values in Higher Education in IIIT, Hyderabad from 6 – 8 Jan, 2012.
- Came into interaction with Prof. Ganesh Bagaria-ji
- 21 faculty and staff of the RUB attended the 8-day workshop in IIT, Kanpur
- Subsequently, Directors, faculty and staff of colleges attended
- 8 day UHV workshop was held at Gaeddu College of Business Studies from 12 to 19 September 2012
- 12 RUB staff, including 4 college Directors attended PSL2 (Introductory Workshop Level 2) held from 14-20 Oct 2012 at MS3 (Manaviya Shiksha Sanskar Sansthan), Kanpur.





- Staff and students attended subsequent workshops in IIT, Kanpur, IIIT, Hyderabad and Gaeddu College of Business Studies, Gedu, Bhutan
- As decided in the 27th AB meeting of the university, UHV courses have been introduced in all RUB colleges since July 2013
- All RUB colleges have already started delivering UHV courses as part of the main academic curriculum one college offers as credited course
- Workshop for the community
- Translate into 'Dzongkha official language of Bhutan' for the benefit of the community and non-English speaking target group.
